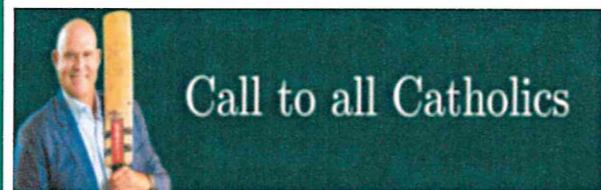

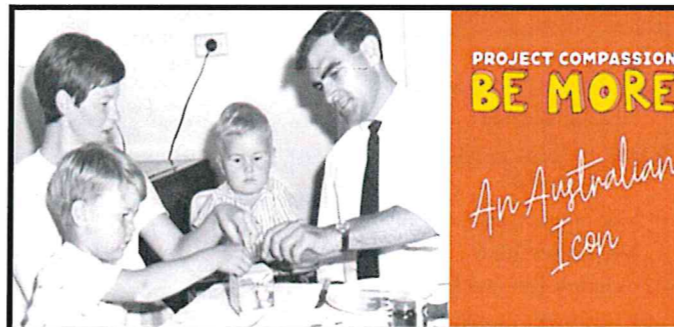

SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD—4TH APRIL 2021

Dear Friends and Families,
"Jesus is Lord, He is risen!" I wish you all a very warm Easter wishes.

Phoenix is a bird of Egyptian mythology. When the bird feels its death is near, it would fly off to Phoenicia, build a nest of aromatic wood and set itself on fire. When the bird was consumed by the flames, a new phoenix sprang forth from the ashes. Thus, the phoenix symbolizes immortality, resurrection, and life after death. It sums up the Easter message perfectly.

Jesus gave up His life, and from the grave He was raised to Life again on the third day. New life rises from the ashes of death. Today, we are celebrating Christ's victory over the grave, the gift of eternal life for all who believe in Jesus. Why Paul writes: "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain; and your Faith is in vain." Because the Resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian Faith. Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection. Jesus assured Martha this at the tomb of Lazarus: "I am the Resurrection and the Life; whoever believes in Me will live even though he dies."

Easter gives us hope and encouragement in this world of pain, sorrows, and tears. It reminds us that life is worth living. It is our belief in the Real Presence of the Risen Jesus in our souls, in His Church, in the Blessed Sacrament, that gives meaning to our personal as well as our communal prayer, strength to fight against temptations, and freedom from unnecessary worries and fears. Easter gives us the joyful message that we are a "Resurrection people." We are not supposed to lie buried in the tomb of our sins, evil habits, addictions and despair. Instead, we are expected to live a joyful and peaceful life, constantly experiencing the living Presence of the Risen Lord in all the events of our life.

May the Risen Lord be a living experience to us infusing every area of our life, bless us, strengthen us, inspire us, guide us, and support us.

I wish to thank you for all your support, especially the office assistance that you extend in the forms of time, talent and tressure on this situation to lift up our community. Let's be open to God and to this community with an open heart and mind to heal and to support.

May the Risen Lord strengthen us in the faith of the resurrection.
Wish you all a Happy and Blessed Easter.
