SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT 4TH DECEMBER, 2022

JOHN THE BAPTIST: A MARVELOUS ADVENT MODEL

Advent is a time we reflect on Lord's coming in History, Mystery and in Majesty. In history the coming our Lord in the historic person of Jesus of Nazareth, in mystery WORD becoming flesh through the mystery of incarnation and in Majesty the second coming Our Lord in glory.

The first reading from the book of Isaiah is the prophecy of a new future in Israel's history to be delivered by a ruler on whom the spirit of the Lord will rest and he would be able to judge justice for the poor and lowly of the land. The people of God much awaited for the coming of Messiah. This prophecy was fulfilled in the incarnation of Jesus who came to save the humanity from the clutches of sin.

The second reading from Romans invites us to be people of hope with "steadfastness and encouragement". The gospel Reading (Mt. 3:1-12) presents the marvelous advent model of John the Baptist who prepared himself and a nation for Lord's coming.

John the Baptism prepared himself and Israel for Lord's coming through two ways.

Firstly, by preaching Baptism of Repentance.

Baptism of repentance preached by john two fundamental aspects namely identification of sins and repentance over sins. John wanted everyone of the land to be prepared for messiah's coming through repentance. That is why he called Pharisees and Sadducees "Brood Vipers" as they had no intention of a change of heart. (Mt. 3:7).

Secondly, by his own life and example.

The words of John were so powerful as it drew people from all over Israel as gospel narrates it as follows - "Then Jerusalem and all Judea and all the region about the Jordan were going out to him..." (Mt. 3:5). As the proverbial saying, "actions speaks louder than words", John the Baptist's deeds and life spoke louder than his powerful words!

Austerity in the life style of John was seen in his attire and diet. "John's clothes were made of camel's hair, and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey." (Mt. 3:4). All these expressed his simple and devote life in preparation for Lord's coming.

John's **humility** is seen in his witness to Jesus on Jesus' arrival to be baptized by John. "I baptize with water those who repent of their sins and turn to God. But someone is coming soon who is greater than I am--so much greater that I'm not worthy even to be his slave and carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire." (Mt. 3:11). John pronounced these words when he was at the peak of popularity and glory. John teaches us that humility always leaves a space for God to work miracles.

In advent, looking into john the Baptist as an advent model, let us give priority to repentance before we would go for shopping, parties and make material preparations. A good advent confession and recollection would the best possible way of preparation for Christmas.

I wish you and your family an Advent season of hope, joy and peace and that the power of the Holy Spirit fills your heart. May your Christmas be a joyous time with family and friends near and far and may you be safe and healthy.
