

# Fourth Sunday of Easter — Year A 30th April 2023

### **QUEEN OF MAY**



The month of May has been accentuated as a time of honouring Blessed Virgin Mary as "the Queen of May" and seeking her intercession by the Catholics for centuries. May devotions may differ in various countries, parishes and families. We celebrate the Marian month with special pilgrimages, devotions, recitation on novena and rosary, visits to churches dedicated to her or placing a crown on a statue of Mary. This is the month in which, in the churches and individual homes, the most affectionate and fervent homage of prayers and devotions from the hearts of Christians are raised to Mother Mary.

Pope Paul VI promulgated his encyclical *Mense Maio* ("The Month of May") in 1965, which promoted May devotions to the Blessed Mother with the message that those who encounter Mary encounters Christ likewise. One reason the devotion has come to extend over the entire month is the abundance of Marian feast days in May namely 'Mary, Queen of Apostles' on the Saturday before Pentecost which falls on May 27th, this year, 'Our Lady of Fatima' on 13<sup>th</sup> May, 'Mary Help of Christians' on 24<sup>th</sup> May, and the 'Visitation of Mary' on 31<sup>st</sup> May.

Mary has a unique and privileged place in salvation history and in the Church. Because she responded yes to becoming the Mother of God, she is our first model of discipleship and our model of grace and trust in God. May is traditionally dedicated in a special way to honoring and seeking the intercession of Mary as the Mother of God and Mother of the Church.

Let us include the following gestures and practices to honour Mary in the month of May namely adorning of Mother Mary, light candles and say a special prayer, pray a novena for a particular intention that you want to entrust to her Immaculate Heart, add more Marian hymns and prayers especially rosary and encourage others to do the same, read books associated with Marian miracles and apparitions, mysteries of her life, virtues and share with others articles of Marian devotion.

Let us pray to Mother Mary – 'Queen of May' to intercede for the needs of the Church and the whole human race.

# Priority Two: Reshaping Parish Communities

"Our current structures are based upon the facts of an earlier time and our current mode of provision is unsustainable. In the cities at least we have too many parishes and too many churches. Urban parishes were established on the assumption that people had to be able to walk to church and at a time when the numbers attending Mass were much larger. Many of our parishes are pressed financially and cannot provide the range of services which a missionary Church requires. Therefore, we need - sensibly and over time - to move towards larger configurations of a community of communities where the concentration of personnel and the sharing of resources would allow a greater range of services for the sake of the Gospel."
