Greetings in the name of the Risen Christ....

Christ is risen! He is truly risen! Alleluia! 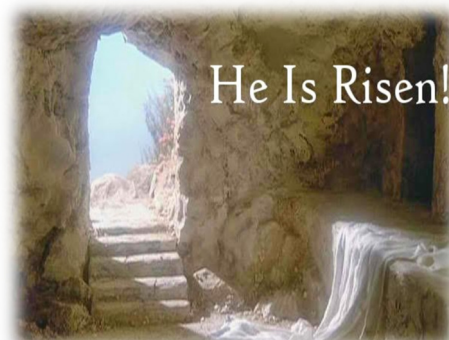
