Feast of the Ascension

The church celebrates the Feast of the Ascension today, beginning with the Incarnation of Jesus and ending with His Second Coming. There are six important components of Christian faith: the Incarnation, the Death, the Resurrection, the Ascension, Pentecost and the Second Coming. The very act of the Ascension of Jesus brings the fruit of the Ascension, which is two Advents or two Comings; the coming of the Holy Spirit and the Second Coming of Christ at the end of the world as the Judge.

Jesus' Ascension into heaven constitutes the end of the mission that the Son received from the Father and the beginning of the continuation of this mission on the part of the Church. This mission will last until the end of history and every day will have the assistance of the Risen Lord.

In this Solemnity, the invitation of our Lord, who finishes his mission in this world, strongly echoes, while leaving us to sit at the right hand of the Father and sends us the strength from above, the Holy Spirit. We as followers of Christ, should have the fire burning inside, the fire that cannot be extinguished.

MISSION 'ENDING' & MISSION 'SENDING'

The Holy See has announced, "Speak with the heart: Veritatem facientes in caritate" as the theme for World Day of Social Communications this year, May 21, 2023. Thus, Ascension Sunday is also World Social Communication Day!

By His Resurrection, Jesus returned to His Father, and His Ascension gives a visible departure marking the end of Easter appearances to His disciples. But 'Ascension' should not be understood as the celebration of Jesus' departure, but the celebration of the living and lasting presence of Jesus with us. "It is good for you that I go back to the Father. For if I do not go the Advocate will not come" (Jn. 16:7).

The rise and expansion of the Internet has not only changed the mode of communication but also the very culture of communication itself. World Social Communication Sunday challenges us to explore the possibilities of communication media for evangelization and to make it a platform for Christian living. If Jesus met people along seashores, in markets and synagogues during His time, today the effective space to meet people to share the Gospel are websites, blogs, wikis, podcasts, virtual forums, social media, etc. The Church must update the modes and culture of the way it communicates, without sacrificing the traditional methods of communication, so that it would not be outdated in a digitalized world. Make your Facebook a 'Faithbook' or My Space a 'Christ Space'. If the church traditionally proclaimed from rooftops, start also proclaiming from laptops!

With the Ascension, the work of Jesus on earth is over and now we are given the baton to run and finish the race successfully, and then hand over the baton to the next generation so that they in turn may run the race well. Let us earnestly desire for the coming of the Holy Spirit who strengthens us in everything.

Knights Silver Circle


