Typically, on a Tuesday or Wednesday mid-morning, we (in twos or threes) meet people who have called the St Vincent de Paul helpline. We provide financial assistance to those in immediate crisis as well as directing them to other organisations where they can receive the help they need. We also provide food vouchers and non-perishable food items, assist with rent and utility bills, provide help in finding furniture and clothing, co-ordinate applications to the St Vincent de Paul Children's Education Fund and No Interest Loan Scheme and, at Christmas time, distribute hampers to needy families in our area; and more.

This is an opportunity to share and connect with others, and to become closer to God because of these rich and rewarding experiences. "Go to the poor, you will find God" - St Vincent de Paul.
