As the year 2023 is coming to an end, we can see the joy of Christmas and New Year everywhere. Now we are on the 4th week of Advent which symbolizes peace. We were prayerfully preparing to receive Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace.

"Glory to God in the highest heaven, and peace on earth to those with whom he is pleased!"(Luke 2:14), is a verse heard everywhere, especially during the Christmas season.

Are we able to find real peace within ourselves, with others, and with God in the chaos of our lives? Are we comfortable? Peaceful? Stressed?
