REFLECTION by Nick Brodie

According to Pope Francis, 'Jesus did not mince words'. Any way you look at it, Christ's proclamation was a turning point in history with phenomenal ramifications. The moment has arrived! The Kingdom of God is close! There is Good News to be heard!

This was Jesus' message about himself. 'He was the salvation,' the Pope notes, who entered human history in a powerfully new way.

When we look at this Gospel, Jesus also had another component of his message: the way of discipleship. Its elements are straightforward: repent, believe, follow.

As the Pope elaborates, Jesus 'invites us to recognise ourselves as in need of God and his grace; to have a balanced attitude with regard to earthly goods; to be welcoming and humble toward everyone; to know and fulfil ourselves in the encounter with and service of others.' This is how we can change our lives to follow more closely the one in whom we believe.

And, as the Pope further suggests, each phase of our life 'has its own value, and can be a privileged moment of encounter with the Lord.' Therefore, we should be open to welcoming Jesus again and again in new places and situations. Whether in our parishes, homes or workplaces, our lives are full of encounters that can change us and

Should you be interested in becoming involved in any of our ministries please contact the office.



WHY WE DO THE THINGS WE DO

Catechumens and Candidates

Why do we distinguish between catechumens and candidates in the RCIA? People sometimes ask.

'Aren't they the same thing? Not exactly.

Catechumen refers to a person who has never been baptised. It was for the unbaptised that they catechumenate originally developed in the early Church, Candidate, on the other hand, refers to the baptised Christian of another denomination who is seeking full communion with the Catholic church. When

we distinguish a candidate from a catechumen we are acknowledging the validity of the former's Christian baptism in another Christian church.
