## Children's Liturgy of the Word

Children's ministry takes place during the Sunday 8am Mass Petrie and 10am Mass Dayboro (during the school term) and provides an opportunity for children to hear a child-friendly version of the Gospel and respond through a range of activities. Our team is passionate about helping children learn more about Jesus and to feel welcomed and engaged in Mass. Children are important in our parish community and we want them to feel a sense of belonging and connectedness. It is so wonderful seeing children gathering together from a range of local schools and developing friendships based on their shared faith. If this is an area you feel called to serve (whether it is to lead a session or to help support the children) please get in touch with the parish office.

## **Baptism Preparation**

Being part of the baptism preparation ministry is a wonderful opportunity to be involved in the beginning of someone's lifelong faith journey. Held on the first Sunday of the month after families are welcomed by the community at the 8am mass, baptism preparation focuses on assisting parents get ready for the sacrament by exploring its deep meaning and rich symbols. It is an important opportunity to encourage families to continue to participate in the faith life of the community as they commit to raising their children as Catholics.

## Sacramental Preparation of Children

Our ministry is one that very much works with and accompanies families as they prepare their children for the sacraments in particular Confirmation, Eucharist and Reconciliation. We aim to provide vibrant and relevant catechesis that engages the parents and children to learn together. We work with children and their families after the 8am Mass on Sundays for an hour at various times during the year. Each Sacrament has a preparation course that goes for three to four weeks, where one of the sessions is a practice for the children to prepare for the actual celebration of the sacraments. If you enjoy working with children and their families and want to help prepare them for these grace-filled times in their lives, then this ministry is for you.

## **RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is an ancient rite that aims to lead adult enquirers into the sacred mystery of Jesus Christ and his Body, the Church, bringing their conversion and faith to maturity in response to the voice of the Holy Spirit. The Word of God and prayer form the basis of RCIA while YouTube videos from our Archdiocese, bishops, priests and Catholic theologians stimulate discussion. The Catechumenate is a gradual process extending throughout the year. The RCIA team has members from both Petrie and Dayboro and we would like to invite you to join us: "**Come and see**". The Catechumenate is a gradual process that has four stages extending throughout the year <u>culminating in the Sacraments of Initiation</u>.

## Funeral Ministry

Christians gather with prayer for our loved one who have died. As Funeral ministry people we come to assist the priest where needed and prepare the church for the funeral. We are there to offer a friendly hand to those visitors and parishioners who have come to offer prayer for the deceased. Also we are ready to assist the funeral director with questions they may have. This is very rewarding ministry **please come and join us**.

## St Vincent de Paul

Volunteering with St Vincent de Paul allows you to help people who are disadvantaged or living in poverty. It's a rich and rewarding experience where we aim to make a positive impact on people's lives. We are able to connect with like-minded people as well as giving back to the Parish and community.

#### WHY WE DO THE THINGS WE DO

Why do we have Stations of the Cross?

Have you ever made a journey retracting the steps of an ancestor? In the early Church a tradition developed whereby Christians would make a pilgrimage to Jerusalem, retracing the journey that Jesus took to Calvary. Visual representation depicting the Passion of Jesus were erected along the way. In memory of this sacred path, the stations were popularised in art and as a devotional practice encouraged especially by the Franciscans. There are fourteen station in our modern day devotion whereby people move from station to station, reflecting on the sacrifice Jesus make for us.
