

WHY WE DO THE THINGS WE DO

The Parish

If a hallmark of the Church is its love and unity, how does this happen in practice? How can millions of Catholics all over the world love one another?! Part of the answer is that the universal Church is comprised of many small cells of community. Individual members experience love and unity at a local level. One way this happens is through the parish. The word *parish* come from the Greek word *paroukia* ('district') which, in the early Church referred to a section of the Christian population under the leadership of the bishop; that is, the equivalent of the modern diocese. From the late 14th century, however, it applied to subdivisions of the diocese.
