#### **Liturgy Committee**

The responsibilities of the Parish Liturgy Committee can be grouped into four areas: preparation, coordination, formation and evaluation. The Liturgy Committee assists the priest in the planning of Sunday Worship, liturgical celebrations, devotions, and significant prayer experiences.

#### **Finance Council**

The Parish Finance Council exists to enable the Parish Priest and the people of Petrie Catholic Parish to work together responsibly in the mission of our Church. The Council's principal responsibility is to provide advice and assistance to our Parish Priest on financial and administrative matters. The Council is made up of members comprised of parishioners by the Parish Priest.

#### **Parish Pastoral Council**

The Pastoral Council consists of the Priest together with a group of parishioners chosen by the parish community. The Pastoral Council's role is to promote the Church's mission to live and communicate the love and values of Christ in our world.

It involves listening and studying the life and activity of the parish to:

- research and identify need, ideas, hopes and feedback of parishioners
- Evaluate parish life and mission in the light of Christ's teaching, broader church initiatives and the values and goals of the parish.
- Develop, implement, review and improve pastoral programs.

#### **PRAYER GROUPS:**

#### **Mothers Prayers:**

Mothers Prayers was formed to help those mothers who wish to pray together for their children and grandchildren and to find the support they need.

Mothers gather Friday mornings at 9am in the Parish Office Prayer Room (during school term).

#### **Fathers Prayers:**

Fathers gather 1st and 3rd Friday of the month following the 8am Mass in Petrie Church, to pray for their children and grandchildren. They learn to surrender their children to the Lord and trust in His plan and purpose for them.

#### **Charismatic Prayer Group:**

Meets for prayer, praise, teaching and intercession for our needs and for the needs of our parish family. They also have personal prayer where they pray for each other's needs. Meetings are held each Monday evening. Phone 3886 1661 for more information.

#### Presentation of the Creed

In family life, values are handed on from on generation to the next, often symbolised through a particular custom, document or treasured heirloom. Throughout the centuries the Church, too, has passed down its most precious beliefs, often symbolised in rituals and prayers, The *Presentation of the Creed* is one such example. In a short ceremony several weeks before their baptism, catechumens are formally presented with the Creed, a statement of Catholic belief. Rather than simply an acquisition of a document, the focus of this ceremony is on the people of the community handing on an enduring tradition of faith to yet another generation of believers.
