Reinstitution of Holy Communion Under Both Species

Receiving from the Chalice ceased with the Covid pandemic, the chalice was reintroduced in some parishes last year. After consultation with Fr Geo, the Liturgy Committee and the Extraordinary ministers of Communion, it has been decided to reintroduce Holy Communion under both species at all weekend Masses from the weekend 2nd June 2024. With this in mind, we now have an opportunity to revisit the Theology of the reception of Holy Communion.

- In the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (Sacrosanctum Concilium, No. 55), the Second Vatican Council spoke to the question of Communion under both kinds. It began by saying, "The dogmatic principles which were laid down by the Council of Trent [remain] intact." Communion under one kind is still the "law." Yet Communion under both kinds "may be granted when the bishops think fit, not only to cleric and religious but also the laity."

The instruction, Redemptionis Sacramentum, regarding the Most Holy Eucharist, Chapter IV, explains:

- (100). "So that the fullness of the sign may be made more clearly evident to the faithful in the course of the Eucharistic banquet, lay members of Christ's faithful, too, are admitted to Communion under both kinds, in the cases set forth in the liturgical books, preceded and continually accompanied by proper catechesis regarding the dogmatic principles on this matter laid down by the Ecumenical Council of Trent"
- (104) "The communicant must not be permitted to intinct the host himself in the chalice, nor to receive the intincted host in the hand, As for the host to be used for the intinction, it should be made of valid matter, also consecrated: it is altogether forbidden to use non-consecrated bread or other matter". In other words unless there is valid reason and approved by the bishop or priest intinction is not allowed.

The act of Communion, is also an act of faith. For when the priest or Extraordinary Minister of Communion says, "The Body of Christ" or "The Blood of Christ," the communicant's "Amen" is a profession in the presence of Christ, body and blood, soul and divinity.

We are pleased to offer the Blood of Christ again, however, if you have any reservations receiving from the Chalice please do not feel you have to. The reason we receive Holy Communion under both kinds, is not that we receive more grace than when we receive it under one kind. Some people are happy to receive Holy Communion under both species, this a personal choice.

Parishioners who are ill or who have symptoms of colds/flu etc. are asked to abstain.

WHY WE DO THE THINGS WE DO

Why do we celebrate Trinity Sunday?

God is love. That is the simple and profound truth at the heart of Trinity Sunday. Consider a husband and wife who have loved each other for many years. They approach life with a sense of 'we' rather than 'I'. Paradoxically, instead of losing a sense of self-identity, each spouse discovers a greater sense of uniqueness through the love of the other. This analogy helps us to glimpse the unity of the three persons of the Trinity. God is persons in a relationship of perfect unity; unique persons, but completely one. In a society full of isolated individuals crying out 'Who am I?' on a restless search for self-identity, the feast of the Trinity calls us to ask another question: *Whose am I? To who do I belong?* Through relationships of love, we discover God.
